Duties and Responsibilities

Under the supervision of the Non-proliferation and Arms Control Instruments Programme Coordinator, the intern will undertake the following tasks inter alia:

- Conduct research on specific issues related to disarmament, non-proliferation and arms control;
- Draft documents and presentations on themes related to the mandate of the Regional Centre;
- Help to organize and carry out courses, conferences, other special events;
- Conduct media monitoring exercises on topics related to UNLIREC' mandate
- Catalogue data and statistical information;
- Write news articles to showcase UNLIREC's work in the field;
- Translate reports, documents, and/or articles; and/or
- Conduct various project-related administrative tasks.

Competencies
